The class is subject to No.3 keel plate from aft and adjacent plating in A and B strakes, port side (set up) being repaired at the Owners' convenience.


The Havre Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry-dock, bottom coated.

On account of damage through striking a submerged object 8 shell plates faired and minor repairs carried out.

The indented plating as above, has been dealt with.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 11,39, without special condition.
