I herewith enclose a letter received from Messrs. Alfred Holt & Co. with reference to the "EMPIRE RAWLINSON" and it is suggested that Messrs. A. Holt & Co. be given a copy of extracts from the Surveyor's Journal, which are also enclosed.

It will be observed from these records that the Surveyor first visited the vessel on 16th January, 1946, and not the 21st as per para.2 of the enclosed communication.

Para.3:- The Surveyor visited the vessel for Load Line and Dry docking surveys.

Para.4:- When the Surveyor visited the vessel afloat and in dry dock, no information was given to him nor were any repairs observed being carried out to No.4 Tank and he has no knowledge of any stiffeners being straightened.

I shall be pleased to learn that the above proposal is concurred in.
