I beg to acquaint you that the General Committee have had before them the cases of your steamers "INDIA MARU", "NORFOLK MARU", "TAKAO MARU" and "WALES MARU", referred to in your letters of the 9th January addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Kobe, from which it is noted that you do not desire to continue the vessels' classification in this Society's Register Book.
