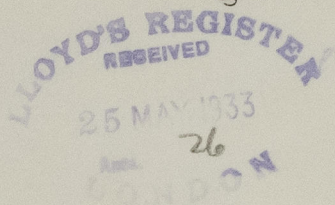

Dear Sir,

With reference to your letters of 16th and 17th instants respecting the Convention freeboard for the above vessel. I beg to state nothing was done while the vessel was again at Rouen. However, I left a letter, in the French language, on board clearly setting forth what is required.
