I am in receipt of your letter of the 19th inst., requesting that an opportunity might be given for checking the Free-Board Marks of this steamer, so that new certificates in the new name may be issued, and we beg to advise you that this might be carried out in Leith almost any Monday, the vessel always sailing from that port every Monday evening.

I have advised the Master of the steamer and also Messrs. H. Robb & Co., Leith, to attend at the vessel next Monday the 26th inst., to have everything in readiness should your Surveyor be able to attend then.

With regard to 2nd Special Survey No. 2, which is now due, I advised you in mine of the 29th September, 1924, that we hoped the vessel would be drydocked about the end of the year, and the Special Survey might then be carried out but regret to say that we have not had an opportunity of placing her in drydock but will make a point of doing so before the expiry of the Year of Grace. We hope that this will then be acceptable to you.
