Nature of Survey When due

This tanker was built in 1944 and classed 100A1 with this Society.

A Periodical Special Survey (A) became due 12.48.

The class is subject to windlass centre frame casting (s.s.) being renewed at the first opportunity, and to (a bower anchor and 30 fathoms of chain cable being supplied).

In reply to enquiry, the ALGIERS Surveyor, in a memorandum dated 25.2.49, states:

"To-day I learnt from Lloyd's Agents, Oran, that the above vessel was classed with the Bureau Veritas as and from the 1st January, 1949".

IT IS SUBMITTED that as the PERIODICAL SPECIAL SURVEY is now 3 months overdue, the vessel's class be expunged from the Register Book and a red line (—) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at the Owners' request.

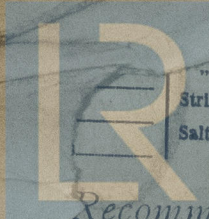
