Dear Sir,

In accordance with the Rules of this Society, as annexed, I beg to inform you, that having inspected your vessel, I respectfully recommend as necessary that Heavy Weather Damage to the HULL, starboard side (Started rivets in bilge of forward part of No 1 Hold in way of Fore Peak Bulkhead) should be permanently repaired at the vessel's next drydocking in order to her being reported to the Committee as entitled to retain her character in the Register Book.

Extracts from the Rules of the Society, Sections 22, 23:—

Section 22.—When the Surveyors consider repairs to be requisite they are respectfully to communicate the same in writing to the Owner, Master or Agent; and if such repairs be not entered upon within a reasonable time, a corresponding report is to be made, as soon as possible, to the Committee for their decision thereon.

All repairs of Ships or Machinery required at Ports where there is a Surveyor to this Society, in order to their obtaining a Character in the Register Book, or to their retaining the Characters assigned to them therein, must be carried out under the inspection, and to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors. Ships or Machinery repaired at Ports where there is no Surveyor to this Society, must be surveyed by one of the Society's Surveyors at the earliest opportunity.

Section 23.—Parties considering the repairs suggested by the Surveyor to be unnecessary or unreasonable, may appeal to the Committee who will direct a special survey to be held; but should the opinion of the Surveyor be confirmed by the Committee, then the expense of such special survey is to be paid by the party appealing.
