Dear Sir,

We duly received your letter of the 27<sup>th</sup> ultimo, regarding Completion Certificate for the S.S. "War Dirk" built by The Caledon Shipbuilding and Engineering Co. (Yard No 260) with reference to the testing of derricks in this vessel, the Portment of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding re-informed the builders that "they will be quite in order making the derricks to stand three ton lifts." The reification test of six tons is therefore no longer required. The vessel's departure from the Tay was delayed for a short time owing to foggy weather, and the Caledon Co. inform us that the captain saw the derricks satisfactorily tested to three tons before leaving. They also state that they will deal with the bent foremast when it is convenient for the vessel to again visit Dundee.
