This vessel holds the notation of "Examined 6.46", with 6 months' validity.

The class is subject to indented bottom plating etc. being permanently repaired at the first convenient opportunity (a bower anchor being supplied).

The vessel is now owned by the South China Navigation Ltd.

The HONG KONG Surveyor reports (3.47) the vessel generally examined afloat with a view to extending Load Line Certificate for 6 months.

It is stated the vessel will be docked within 2 months for general examination and repairs for maintenance of class.

The Surveyor recommends the trading limits be restricted meaning Hong Kong Harbour and the adjacent inland waters.

It is submitted ACTION be DEFERRED for a short time for General Examination.
