We should be glad to hear whether the two Anchors of 8 cwt 14lbs. will meet your requirements.

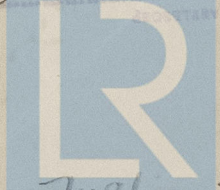
We may say the test of each is 10.2 tons.
