I have accordingly telegraphed to you to this effect, as below, which is hereby confirmed.

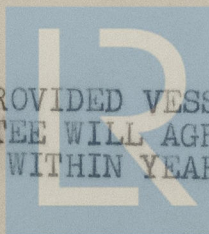
