In cases which have to be submitted to the Classing Committee "the endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—(Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92).

Nature of Survey..... When due.....

The PERIODICAL SPECIAL SURVEY (A) became due 7.48.

The class is subject to permanent repairs to indented shell plating etc., (p & s), to stem and stem plating, and to profile plate of sternframe at the first convenient opportunity, to hull riveting at the first opportunity, and to (a bower anchor and 45 fathoms of chain cable being supplied, and two bower anchors and stream anchor on board being submitted to the Statutory Test).

In reply to an enquiry re. the Owners' intentions regarding Classification of the vessel, the Paris Office in a memorandum dated 2.3.49 state that this vessel is now classed with Bureau Veritas.

This is submitted for the consideration of the COMMITTEE in view of the Special Survey being eight months overdue.
