I duly received your letter of the 7th ultimo in connection with the above vessels and note your remarks.

With regard to the desired service, namely "East Coast of Canada and the United States of America but not north of Anticosti Island; in the Gulf of Mexico, to the West Indies, and on the North Coast of South America but not south of Georgetown", for the "MAYTHORNE" and "MAYSPRING" I have to state that these service limits could be approved, but I shall be glad if you will let me know by cablegram whether the service north of 36° North should not be limited to between the 1st April and the 31st October, as in the case of the "OTTAWA MAYCLOUD".
