Dear Sir:-

With reference to the notice of Amended Assignment of Freeboard, of January 16th, I have to report that the depth of hatchway is 12 inches at the centre and 8 inches at the ends.

The means of closing the steel covers on trunk top consist of bolts hinged to the coaming and turning up into a U shaped clip on the cover, bolts fitted with wing nuts, wings 6 inches long.

The remaining items are the same as reported for the sister ship the "MANUEL RIONDA" which is a duplicate of the "W.E. OCILVIE" in every respect.
