The class is subject to set in sheerstrake plating, etc. (s.s.f.) being examined and dealt with as necessary, and to wasted deck plating being dealt with, all by Special Survey, by 6,54.

There is an Endorsement of Class(B).

A SPECIALS SURVEY (C) became due 6,53. Postponement until 6,54 approved 15.6.53 provided a satisfactory General Examination is held in dry dock before commissioning. The requirements of a General Examination partly held at Cpn. 7,53 and 3,54.

ACTION is DEFERRED for Special Survey.


