Dear Sir,

Referring to your letter S. dated the 11th instant regarding our report No 12323 on the steamer "CLARA" I have to inform you that the Owners have proposed to fit a 3" direct bilge suction from the independent Ballast pump to the starboard engine bilge. This suction which will be made with strum-box and straight tail pipe will be fitted at the earliest convenient opportunity.

With reference to the last paragraph in your letter I have to say that the present ballast pump direct suction is carried to same valve in the port side as the bilge injection.

The non compliances of this arrangement with the Rules were pointed out to the Owners at an early date of the repairs, but Burmeister & Wain refused, due to shortage of man-power to make the alteration.
