This vessel was built in 1925 to Germanischer Lloyd class, and the last Special Survey was held at Copenhagen in August 1945.

The COPENHAGEN Surveyors report (1.47) the vessel afloat and a GENERAL EXAMINATION carried out.

The Owners state the vessel will be dry-docked and submitted for Special Survey next Spring.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to have notation of "Examined L.R. 1.47" assigned WHEN she has been examined in dry dock, but NO ACTION be taken meantime.
