The Liverpool Surveyors write this vessel is now in dry dock there for the examination of her bottom, etc. They forward a letter received by them from the Owners' Superintendents in which they state that as men could not be obtained to draw in the screw shaft in the time at their disposal in Graving Dock they trust the Committee will allow the survey to stand over until the first favourable opportunity. The Superintendents add that the shaft which is fitted with a continuous liner has been running quite satisfactorily and is not down in the bush.
