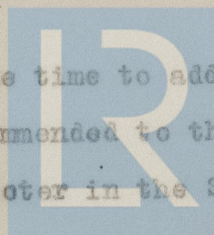

Dear Sir,

S. With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "HEATHER KING", which vessel it is understood has now become your property, I am directed to acquaint you that the case of this steamer occupied the attention of the Committee to-day, together with a communication received from the Society's Surveyors at Swansea, from which it appears that it is not your intention to continue the Society's class.

In the circumstances, and in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of the Second Special Survey No.2 expired in July last, the Committee have had no alternative but to expunge the class from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have at the same time to add that the vessel will be eligible to be recommended to the Committee for the re-instatement of her character in the Society's Register
