I am in receipt of a letter from Lloyd's Register of Shipping, 71 Fenchurch St., London E.C.3, dated June 24th, 1932, requesting information as to when special survey of boilers S.S. "CANORA" can be effected.

I have to inform you that the S.S. "CANORA" has now been laid up at Port Mann and out of commission since February 4th, 1932.

As there are no prospects in the immediate future of any business for this vessel, I should like to postpone this particular survey until a later date.

My intentions are to put this vessel through the general overhaul and survey previous to starting operations when sufficient business warrants placing this vessel into commission once more.
