With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "FRANCUNION V", I beg to remind you that the Second Special Survey No.2 became due in October 1932 but has not yet been held, and the year of grace allowed for the survey has consequently expired.

The Committee have had the case before them today together with a letter from the Society's Paris Office, from which it appears that the vessel is laid up indefinitely at Algiers, and in all the circumstances I have to say that the Committee will be agreeable to the vessel's class in the Register Book remaining undisturbed for the present whilst she is laid up, subject to the conditions set forth on the enclosed form of undertaking, which I shall be glad if you will kindly sign and return to this Office in due course.
