M/V "JACO". - Cpn. Rpt. No 12340.

Referring to your letter of the 14th inst. respecting the above named ship we beg to state that the length of the forecastle to be inserted in the Register Book is 34'.

With regard to the parts welded we beg to state that it was only minor secondary items that were welded, shell, deck, frames and beams being riveted.

The inner surface of the bottom is covered with cement in the Fresh water tanks and with Bitumastic enamel in all the other tanks.

As the ship is at present trading outside Denmark it has not been possible to measure the overall length of the vessel, but this will be done at the ship's first visit to Copenhagen.
