Dear Sirs,

S. The contents of your report No.12340 on the Motorship "JACO" are noted and so far as the hull is concerned the case is ready for submission to the Committee for assignment of a class of ~~SA~~ Al With Freeboard, "For Coasting Service Oslofjord Kattegat & Baltic, also Hamburg via Kiel Canal" with notation of S.S.Cpn.-1,48.

So far no First Entry report has been received on the machinery and such a report will be necessary before the recommended notation of IMC can be assigned. It is assumed that in this instance the main engines were built under the supervision of the Society's Surveyors on behalf of the Ministry of Supply and should this be so the serial numbers of the engines will be found stamped on brass plates at the forward end of the engines.

It will therefore be appreciated if you can ascertain these numbers and advise me as soon as possible so that particulars of the engines can be obtained from the records in this Office.
