Dear Sirs,

I return herewith one copy of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 19th instant, showing the arrangements of the open tween deck aft, including the details of the door in the shell, for Messrs. Earle's Shipbuilding & Engineering Co's No. 678, and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the arrangements be carried out as shown and amended thereon, and to your satisfaction, they will be approved.

The duplicate plan is being retained for record.

It is observed that the side opening aft has been increased in length to about 12'-6", and that an open stairway is proposed to be fitted between frames Nos. 23 & 25 on the port and starboard sides, and I have to say that with these amendments the provisional freeboards as intimated in my letter of the 1st instant will be increased  $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
