I have to inform you that Convention ordinary and timber deck cargo freeboards have been computed in the case of the steamer "JAN" on the basis of the information supplied in Helsingborg report C.11 No.694, which is enclosed herewith together with timber computation and Swedish Freeboard Certificate in triplicate.

I may add that the penalty required by the Swedish Authorities for the omission of a hood at the after end of the raised quarter deck has been applied.


