With reference to your freeboard report No. 3379 on the Steamer "CITO", I enclose herewith the usual letter giving particulars of the freeboards which have been assigned to this vessel, subject to facilities being fitted to enable the crew to get to and from their quarters without descending into the well.

I have to inform you that if the bridge front stiffening and bracketing be made equivalent to the requirements of the Freeboard Regulations, page 26, a Summer freeboard of 1'-3" could be assigned.
