Steamer "TEWFIK"

Upon receipt of your letter of the 18th ultimo, I have after many difficulties and delays, managed to communicate with Owners Local Agents, Messrs. Abdulla Fazil Arab & Co., Cairo, who on the 12th instant replied as follows:-

"We beg to inform you that we again sent a telegram to the Owner of the above named steamer requesting him to cable us the definite arrangements regarding the surveys of this vessel, and as soon as the reply comes to hand we shall immediately communicate with you".

I have again to-day, contacted the Agents, but they are still not in a position to advise us regarding this matter.

The Owner of this vessel is known to me personally, and whilst I believe he must be interested in maintaining the class, I know that he was also anxious to sell the vessel, as he was experiencing considerable difficulty in obtaining trade.

There is still a possibility of receiving a reply from the Owner at Beyrouth but they will have ample time until the end of this month.
