Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

This vessel has been requisitioned by the Sea Transport Authorities and as a temporary measure the following alterations have been effected:-

Additional accommodation fitted in No.1 tween decks, a steel bulkhead has been fitted in same 1 space forward of No.1 hatch.

Space entered by companionway in forecastle house with steel door 4'-9" x 24" operated from both sides with 15" coaming (originally store space).

Additional accommodation fitted in No.2 tween decks with a steel bulkhead fitted 1 space aft of No.2 tween decks. Space entered through tonnage space.

Tonnage hatch permanently closed and a steel companionway fitted on same with 4'-9" x 30" wood door operated from both sides with 24" coaming.

Steel companionways fitted at after end of Nos.1 & 2 hatches with steel watertight doors 4'-6" x 24" operated from both sides and with coaming 6" above hatch coaming.

The vessel has been fitted for the carriage of spirit in self contained tanks fitted in holds. Separate sounding & filling pipes fitted with air pipes led up mast.
