THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Undersigned Surveyors to this Society did, at the request of the Admiralty, survey during construction the hull, machinery and electrical equipment of the steel screw steamer "EMPIRE MOULMEIN", 7047 tons gross register of South Shields, built by Messrs. John Readhead & Sons Ltd., South Shields.

The ship and machinery have been built and equipped in accordance with the requirements of the Society for Class ~~AL~~100A1 with freeboard, 8.44, <sup>L.M.C.</sup> ~~ALMC~~ 8.44, ~~AL~~Lloyd's R.M.C. (with date) when the survey has been completed.

All the requirements of the finally approved plans and Admiralty "as fitted" specifications have been carried out.

The trials of the main and auxiliary machinery, the steering gear and windlass were carried out in the River Tyne at Builders' Quay by 4th August, 1944, with satisfactory results.
