Dear Sir,

A. With reference to your letter of the 8th instant, respecting the case of the Steamer "CAMBRONNE" (Glasgow first entry report No. 38901), I have to inform you that an account has to-day been rendered to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for the proportion of the fees due in respect of the construction of this Standard Vessel up to the time of transfer to private ownership, viz:- 50% of the difference of the fees on the hull and machinery of the vessel chargeable at 1/4 per ton and the ordinary classification fees, as under:-

For survey of Hull.....	£16. 0. 0.
" " " Machinery.....	12. 0. 0.

I shall therefore be glad if you will see that the necessary entries are now made in the Glasgow Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.

I have to add, with regard to this case, that it is concluded that the stiffeners on the engine and boiler room bulkheads are as approved, but I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the Surveyor and let me know whether this is so.
