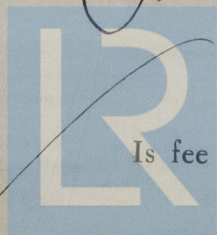
I have to report that I have surveyed the Steamer
"CAMBRONNE" of Nantes O.N. _____
on this date.

I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with those given in the original freeboard report and I have found them to be in agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient condition.

No alterations have taken place in the Hull or superstructure. The fittings and appliances for the protection of openings in the deck and Ship's Sides, the guard Rails, freeing ports and means of access to Crew's quarters have been found or placed in good Condition. The Vessel has been surveyed in dry dock at St Nazaire in June 1936, and is now undergoing at Nantes, a Complete Special Survey no. 1.

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given on certificate No. _____ dated 14th January 1935, which is returned herewith. (*With the Certified Copy*)
