S.S. "INCHJURA"

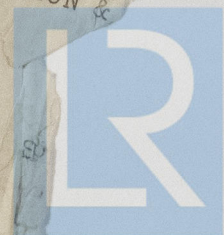
We duly received your letter of 9th August, 1955, and note the information that the Surveyors directed you to pass on to us. The situation regarding this ship is as follows.

We acquired her in India in January and Special Survey (after 1 year's G.E. granted to previous Owners) due in July, 1955, when the vessel was trading at sea on Charter, due for re-delivery Hong Kong early August when we intended to put her through Survey, that being the first for such work to be done. On her arrival at Hong Kong of re-classification was immediately put in hand.

It is true that for reasons we believe we explained to your satisfaction, the ship is being re-classified to Veritas' Class, but as we mentioned to you before, ships are with Lloyd's, and we would not like to be holding us responsible for a non-compliance with Society's Rules.

Will you be so very kind as to explain to the Surveyors which has possibly been misunderstood in London.
