With reference to the Special Survey on the above ship which becomes due at the end of the present month.

We have received a letter dated 11th January from the Owners in Genoa, a free translation of which is herewith attached for your information, and from which it will be noted that they are requesting that the items done by Registro Italiano for Special Survey in November last while the ship was in Genoa, be accepted as part of the Survey, by our Society.

The position, as far as we now know, is that the ship was under R.I. survey at Genoa from the 3rd to 21st November.

We received absolutely no notification that the Owners desired to commence the Special Survey at that time, nor did we know that the R.I. Surveyors were called upon to survey the ship for Special Survey.

Both the Owners and R.I. have now been contacted on the subject and the Owners, on their part, said that they were under the impression that it was not necessary to call our Surveyors as they presumed that parts examined by Registro Italiano would be accepted by Lloyd's Register; while Registro Italiano say that it should be the Owners' responsibility to request our Surveyor to attend, this may be so, but I still think the R.I. Surveyors might have informed our Surveyors that they were doing part S.S. and I have told R.I. Headquarters so.
