Dear Sirs,

With reference to your first entry report No. 71371 on the boilers No. 312B, built by Messrs. The Wallsend Slipway & Engineering Co., Ltd., for the S.S. "PEEBLES" (ex "WAR PETUNIA"), Messrs. Richardson, Duck & Co's No. 675 vessel, I have to inform you that 50% of the difference between the machinery fees as a Standard Vessel and the ordinary classification fees are chargeable to the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding in this case, viz: -£36, and an account has been rendered for these fees accordingly.

Of this amount, £9 will be due to your port for the survey during construction of the boilers, and the balance to the Middlesbrough Office. You will therefore be good enough to see that this amount is now passed through your Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
