Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 12th instant, respecting the fees to be charged for the survey of the S.S. "PEEBLES", Messrs. Richardson, Duck & Co's No.675 vessel, "A" Type, I have to inform you that the ordinary classification fees will be chargeable to the builders, viz:-

<u>Hull.</u>	<u>Machinery.</u>
First entry....£ 5. 0. 0.	£ 3. 0. 0.
Special Survey fees.... <u>£148. 12. 0.</u>	<u>£42. 15. 0.</u>
<u>£153. 12. 0.</u>	<u>£45. 15. 0.</u>

In addition to the above fees, 60% of the difference between the fees as a standard vessel and the ordinary classification fees will be chargeable to the ~~builders~~ of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for the survey of the Hull, and 50% of the difference of the machinery fees, of £48 and £36 respectively.

An account for the fees chargeable to the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding will be sent from this office on receipt of the completed first entries on the case, but you will nevertheless, be good enough to see that these fees are entered on the reports.
