Engines by Blairs Ltd., Glasgow.
Now lying at Garelochhead near Helensburgh until
20th March, 1952.

Thereafter she will go to Messrs. Harland & Wolff
at Govan for refit by Admiralty which is expected
to be completed about 20th June, 1952.
