REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE FOR **DOCKING**

Vessel placed in floating dock, bottom and rudder cleaned, examined and recoated. Examined decks, hatch coamings and covers, casings, ventilators and coamings, skylights, scuppers, windlass, steering gear and connections and found in order.

DAMAGE (1) 15.8.55 at BOL:- Shell plate No.5 in 1st strake below sheer stbd. side renewed; 1 frame in way cropped and part renewed.

DAMAGE (2) 25.11.55 at ROGAC:- Soft nose indents faired in place; indent in sheer strake plate No.2 from aft port side faired in place; Sheer strake plates port side between frames 44-45 and at frame 20 faired in place.

DAMAGE (3) alleged sustained on 8.2.1956 in the shipyard at Split through vessel touching ground during N.O.gale: Paint on bottom plates and bar keel scraped, no other apparent damage found.
