I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 5th instant, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that all particulars of the Steamer "PORTOL" were omitted from the Register Book after receipt of a request from the Admiralty that her class should be allowed to lapse. Similar cases are those of the "BRIGOL", "CHLOROL", "PRESTOL" and "SERBOL", and arrangements are now being made for all particulars of these vessels to be omitted from the next reprint of the Register Book in order to bring them in line with the "PORTOL".

It is concluded no information has been received by you concerning proposed reclassification of any of the above vessels.
