Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 15th instant respecting the Wood 3-masted Schooner "MARIE JEANNE", and in reply thereto I am directed to authorise you to carry out the survey of this vessel with a view to classification, provided Mr. Demarest, the Society's Surveyor at Nantes, joins in the survey.

I have further to state that Section 60 of the Rules for wood vessels, Second Survey for the A in red class should be fully complied with, the greatest care should be exercised, and an additional fee of twenty guineas to be credited to this office should be charged for classification, in addition to the ordinary survey fees.

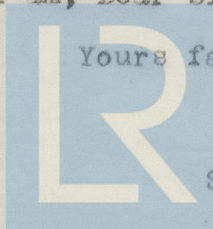
I shall be glad if you will communicate with Mr. Demarest and advise him of the Owners' decision in the matter.
