

Wood 3-masted Sc. "~~MARIE JEANNE~~".

This vessel was built in 1902 and has never been classed.

In a letter dated the 13th instant the St. Malo Surveyor states "that he has been asked by Messrs. Beron & Co. to survey this vessel with a view to purchase. The vessel has been laid up at St. Servan for over five years, in consequence of which the upper part of the vessel had to be completely renewed".

// The new owner has requested the Surveyor to recommend and survey the necessary repairs which are now in execution."

// The vessel is now practically rebuilding and the owners have requested the Surveyor to have the ship classed in Lloyd's Register."

It is submitted that the Surveyor should be authorised to carry out the survey for classification provided he be joined in the survey by Mr. Demarest.

The Surveyors should carry out Section 60 Second Survey for A in red in wood rules.

The greatest care should be exercised and an additional fee of 20 guineas should be charged for classification in addition to the ordinary surveying fees.
