arks A proposal to postpone the Special Survey until the end of July/beginning of August, 1958, was agreed to 20.5.58.

The year of grace for the Special Survey expired at the end of July, 1958.

On 6th August a request that the Special Survey be further postponed for three months until the ship's return to Japan was not agreed to, and the Yokohama Surveyors were informed that the Special Survey must then be held or the class would be expunged.

A cablegram on the 11th August from the Hong Kong Surveyors requested that, subject to a satisfactory General Examination at Yokohama, the Committee agree to a three month extension of the time granted for completion of the Special Survey items, enabling the Owners to reduce heavy losses since purchase, and fulfil present commitments with freight assignments to Bankers.
