Surveys due: Special Survey due 7.57 - Postponement of SS until 7.58 approved by General Examinations held at Liverpool 6.57 and Kobe 1.58. Main Boiler Survey due 10.57 - held Kobe 1.58 without a cash record being assigned on condition that a complete boiler survey carried out in 6.58 at the Special Survey. Hull subject - see endorsement 5.2.58.

Remarks: A proposal to postpone the ^{Special Survey} drydocking until the end of beginning of August, 1958 was agreed to 20.5.58.

The year of grace for the Special Survey expired at the end July, 1958.

On 6th August a request that the Special Survey be further postponed for three months until the ship's return to Japan was not agreed to and the Yokohama Surveyors were informed that the Special Survey must be held now or the class would be expunged.

A cablegram from Hong Kong now requests that, subject to a satisfactory General Examination at Yokohama now, the Committee agree a three months extension of the time granted for completion of the Special Survey, enabling the Owners to reduce heavy losses since purchase and fulfil present commitments with freight assignments to shippers.
