Dear Sir,

With further reference to the vessels of the Costeira fleet, I now have to inform you as follows.

A letter has been received from the Superintendente-Ten. Cel. Jose Pinheiro de Ulhoa Cintra-stating it is their intention to maintain the class of the following vessels :-

"ITAQUICE", "ITAHITE", "ITAIMBE", "ITANAGE" & "ITAPE".

They further wish to maintain the class of the remainder of the vessels until surveys become due. These vessels are :-

"ARATANHA", "ARARANGUA", "ARATIMBO", "ITABERA",
"ITAPUHY", "ITAPURA", "ITATINGA", "ITAQUATIA",
"ITAQUERA", "CAMPEIRO", "CAMPINAS", "ITAGUASSU",
"ITAPUCA", "ARARIBA".

It is also stated they do not require further Load Line Surveys on the latter vessels, and it is their intention to have these carried out by the Capitania dos Portos when they fall due.

Of the former vessels I have to inform you that the "ITANAGE" is now at the Owners' Repair Department, where the Special Survey is being completed.
