Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 11th. instant we confirm that we are without any reply from the Owners of the "BRASILUSO", and we are cabling them today.

The "COCAL" has arrived at this port and there has been some doubt as to whether or not she could be drydocked at this time, but we believe now that she will follow the "BRUCE THOMAS" later this week. Owners state that they are making good the chain cable and the position will be reported in due course.

We are endeavouring to make contact with the Owners of the "SANTA CECILIA" and will keep you advised on this case.

The Owners of the "SALTE 50" regret that, due to extensive repairs being carried out to other of their tankers at this port, they will only be able to bring the ship to Rio to carryout the necessary surveys in October next. Eight of their ships are under survey at the moment at Rio.

We have obtained a copy of the Brazilian Authority's Survey report on the S.S. "BURY" and this is being forwarded.

The same Owners drydocked the S.S. "NAVEM MONICA" without advising this Office in March last. Your instructions are awaited.
