Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

Emergency accommodation in No.1 tween decks dispensed with at this time, small hatches in side forecastle and sidescuttles removed and openings efficiently closed, 1 wood door in forecastle front removed and opening plated over.

Accommodation at bridge end. Wood door (p.s) removed and hinged steel W.T. door (18" coaming) operated from both sides fitted (P. & S.)

Additional 8" diameter vents with 30" x 9/16 coamings fitted on bridge deck aft with wood plugs and canvas covers.

Freeboard certificate and copy amended to suit new closing appliances at bridge end.
