Steamer "NATALIE" ex "CHANDLER"

Reverting to my letter dated 1st April last the report of the General Examination held while this ship was at Tilbury between the 19th April and 2nd May has now received the consideration of the Committee. In view of the satisfactory nature of this report, postponement of the Special Survey until January, 1961, has now been approved.

Some temporary repairs were carried out to the auxiliary condenser overboard discharge valve which was found to continue efficient, but it was recommended that this item should be again examined and dealt with as necessary at the next drydocking. The Committee have continued the class subject to this matter receiving attention.
