The engine has now been fitted on board at Wellington, N.Z. and the vessel is now ready for her trials. The following are the particulars of the Engine as fitted: 5 cylinder two stroke, cylinder diameter 340 M/M, stroke 570 M/M giving a maximum output of 725 B.H.P. at 250 R.P.M.
