
Dear Sir,

With reference to our telephone conversation regarding the vessel "SAINTE BERNADETTE" we have now made an examination of the condenser cover in question and provided the provisional repairs recommended by us are carried out, we are of the opinion that the condenser will be satisfactory until you have time to have a new cover made.

We would point out that the class of this vessel was suspended when the Germans took over the South of France, cutting this office off from London.

We assume that the Owners are desirous of having the vessels class maintained in this Society and have written our Principal requesting them to advise him of survey that may be required to give the vessel a fresh record in the Register Book.
