Dear Sir,

M. I am in receipt of the freeboard report No. 43625 on the S.S. "LOUIE ROSE", Messrs. J. Fullerton & Co's Yard No. 274, and with regard thereto I enclose the usual printed letter setting forth the freeboards which have been assigned, subject to facilities being provided to enable the crew to pass to and from their quarters without descending into the well.

At the same time I have to inform you that Mr. Fullerton called at this Office on Saturday morning, the 10th instant, and desired to be informed what modification would be made in the freeboard if the present deckhouse were converted into a bridge house open at the after end.

With regard thereto I shall be glad if you will inform the builders that if the bridge house be altered as proposed, the summer freeboard could be reduced one inch and the winter freeboard half an inch.

The plans, three in number, forwarded for reference are returned herewith.
