Having reference to previous correspondence of the Bremen and Hamburg Offices with London regarding the survey of freeboard under the provisions of the International Load Line Convention to Norddeutscher Lloyd vessels, I beg to enclose herewith Mr. W. Meyer's Freeboard Report for the s.s. "AUGSBURG".

For the particulars of the moulded displacement at 85% of moulded depth and the external displacement for various draughts, I had applied to the Society's Surveyors in Newcastle and requested them to obtain these particulars from the Builders of the vessel, and communicate them to us.
